## 1. The frame of the study visit

### Study visit title:

BRIDGES - Cultural activities and adult education promoting empowerment, participation, and social inclusion.

### Period

The 4-day study visit takes place from Monday morning, 5<sup>th</sup> of Sept to Thursday evening, 8th of September 2022.

## 2. Summary of the Erasmus+ mobility plan

### Context

The study visit is part of the Erasmus+ Mobility project: “BRIDGES - promote social inclusion with participatory culture”, where more study visits has taken and will take place in the period: Aug 2020 – Dec 2022.

The mobility project is coordinated by [Interfolk](#) in cooperation with [Det Frivillige Kulturelle Samråd](#).

### Aim and objectives

The overall aim for this Mobility Project is to transfer new experiences and competences with social inclusive activities to the Danish cross-cultural sector of amateur arts, voluntary culture, heritage, and liberal adult education.

The objectives are:

- To strengthen the exchange of experiences and transfer of new knowledge and skills between cross-cultural and liberal adult education associations in the European civil societies.
- To support and promote cross-cultural activities with added community values as social inclusion, civic empowerment, active citizenship, and community bonding.

### Number and profile of participants

The target groups are staff and volunteers from the network of Interfolk and DFKS, including managers, board members, consultants, teachers, and other paid and voluntary learning facilitators.

Expected number of participants to the Austrian study visit: 7 participants.

### Expected results and benefits

We expect the participants and their associations:

- In general, will strengthen their interest for and engagement in European contacts, exchange of experiences and cooperation.
- Especially, will be more engaged and skilled in supporting cross-cultural activities with added values for social inclusion, empowerment, active citizenship, and community bonding.

## 3. The host organisation and the sending organisations

### The host association



The host is [EDUCULT – Institute of Cultural Policy and Cultural Management](#).

EDUCULT is an independent, non-profit institute providing empirical research and consulting as well as competent cultural management in the fields of culture and education.

EDUCULT aims to connect culture, education and policy in theory and practice. Through our research we aspire to initiate discussion and raise new questions. DFKS wishes to strengthen the visibility of the area, initiate development work, offer courses and further education and provide documentation and statistics in the field.

The local members of the national associations are associations, where volunteers convey, organize, arrange, create frames, etc. for activities within the arts, culture, and heritage; and at the same time, the actors in these activities are always professional and they consist of touring theatres, visual artists and musicians as well as culture researchers, historians, etc.

The voluntary culture associations organise a plethora of arts and cultural services around the country for the benefit of large sections of the population - and perhaps to extra delight in the sparsely populated areas, where there would otherwise not be many opportunities for having experiences with art and culture.

## 4. Programme for the study visit to Vienna

### The Frame

A 4-days trip from Monday morning to Thursday evening, 5th – 8th of September 2022:

#### Re Transport:

- Direct flight 5<sup>th</sup> of Sept with Austrian Airline from Copenhagen Airport (CPH) to Vienna International Airport (VIE), 9:50 – 11:30 (1h 40 min.), and

- Direct return flight 8<sup>th</sup> of Sept from Vienna Airport to Copenhagen Airport: 21:00 – 22:40 (1h. 40 min).
- We have reserved a taxi (a minibus for 7 persons, where the driver awaits us in the airport) both for the drive to our hotel, and the return drive to the airport from the hotel.
- During the visit we will walk for shorter distances and for longer distances use taxis or public transport as the U-Bahn (metro) and the tramps.

#### Re accommodation:

- We stay in single rooms at [Hotel Alpha - Artist Hotel](#), Buchfeldgasse 8, 08. Josefstadt, 1080 Wien. The hotel is located in Vienna's elegant Josefstadt district with its many historic buildings and the Town Hall.
- The hotel is just 350 meters from the Rathaus Underground Station (line U2); and it is just 15 min walk (1 km) from the office of EDUCULT at Museumsplatz 1, 1070 Wien.
- We can have buffet breakfast at the hotel from 6.30 to 10.30 every morning.
- We will have our lunches and dinners in the town as it fits in the programme, and there are also numerous restaurants serving international as well as Austrian cuisine near the hotel.

## 5. Practical information

### Price

The study visit is free. The mobility grant can cover the travel costs, beds, and meals as well as the study programme and fee for the hosts. The Erasmus+ mobility grant will cover the following costs:

- The administration costs of proving the Erasmus+ application and reporting, planning the programme, preparing Mobility Agreements with all participants, booking travels and accommodation, providing Course Certificate and course evaluation.
- The participants' course fee for the 3 days programme which we must pay to our Austrian host organisations.
- The costs of a basic return flight ticket incl. hand baggage and up to 20 kg suitcase, but not extra costs for specific seat reservation, travel insurances, drinks, and meals during the flight.
- The rent of a minibus for local transport from the Airport to and from the hotel as well as local transport during the visits in Vienna Monday – Thursday.
- Booking of beds for a single (or double room if wished) at a hotel in Vienna all 3 nights from Monday to Thursday.
- Provision of main meals as breakfast, lunch, dinner, and coffee breaks all days, from Monday to Thursday.

The participants shall only bring pocket money to cover their possible café visits in the free time, extra drinks during the common meals, costs of souvenirs, presents, etc.

Visa card can be used most places in Vienna, and it is easy to find cash machines in Vienna Airport or in Vienna city.

### Travel and accommodation

The tour leaders will book the flights and hotel, reserve the meals, and organise the local transport in cooperation with the hosts of the programme.
