Programme: As part of the creation of the Culture Strategy 2030, the Department of Culture and Education of the City of St. Pölten and the Institute for Practical Research in the Culture and Education Area EDUCULT invite you to the workshop on Co-Creation.

Co-creation is the new term for increased cooperation between public administrations, local institutions and civil society actors. As part of the EU Erasmus + program, EDUCULT has dealt with the approach and new development processes of co-creative cooperation, especially in the cultural field.

The aim of the workshop is to jointly develop a model or principles for co-creation between organizations in the cultural scene and politics / administration. After an overview of the basics and international examples of co-creation in the cultural sector, questions on how co-creation could be possible implemented within 2030 cultural strategy will be developed interactely.
