First meeting

Two cultural councils responded positively - Guldborgsund and Skive - and 25 May, the first meeting with The Cultural Council of Guldborgsund, which was the first priority took place with the following agenda:

1. Presentation of the participants
2. Project idea
3. Pilot project - idea development
4. Next meeting

Bente von Schindel presented the project idea and the further development. And since it is the members of the local cultural council that themselves should come up with the ideas for the content of the project the cultural council of Guldborgsund presented their idea, which was to revive the cultural traces found on a 10

km stretch in Gedser area - the southern area of the municipality - a sparsely populated area. It is then supposed to involve the population in the area in the work and thus form a community around the project.

The Future

The Cultural Council of Guldborgsund, decreases in the near future a working group, and there will be held an inaugural meeting soon. The chairman of the Cultural Council of Guldborgsund is responsible for the group. The head of the cultural department of the municipality and Bente von Schindel act as a reference group and they are as such from time to time invited to an informational meeting. The next time this will be supplemented by a tour of the countryside around Gedser.
