here's a quick update on the things we have managed to organize and book.

June 1:

- Arrival to Ljubljana at 13:00
- Postojna Cave with an English guide at 16:00 (unfortunately, we were unable to add the Predjama Castle, as the schedule did not line up with the rest of our activities)
- If you need help getting to Postojna or anything around here, I can help you out, as it my hometown

June 2:

- Walk around Ljubljana's Old Town in the morning
- The Ljubljana Castle Time Machine at 13:00 guided tour in English followed by a chat with the actors and main organizers
- Make sure to arrive at the castle a couple of minutes earlier, though Jan will be joining you, so you don't have to worry much
- Meeting with an amateur actress Anka Eržen at 20:00 at the Skyscraper building (here, Jan will be joining you as well)

June 3:

- A workshop where you will be working on fighting scenes with Seba Starič between 10:30-12:30 at JSKD, Cankarjeva 5
- A meeting with the main organizers and some actors from the Ana Monro Theater which organizes the Ljubljana Stories at 16:00 in front of the church at Gornji trg, Ljubljana (one of us will be joining you, probably me). They will take you on the route that is used for Ljubljana Stories and the actors will tell you more about each scene. After this, they proposed a Q&A session over drinks at one of the places nearby, it will probably be in "Pritličje"
- We have arranged a meeting with a few of LARP Slovenia's members at 19:00 (one of us will try to join you). As of place, they will completely adapt to you, however, they did propose meeting at Harat's Pub where you could get to know each other over drinks and dinner if you're up for it

June 4:

- We are planning a meeting with the oldest amateur theater group in Europe Sentjakob Theater it will be at their location, but we will let you know the exact time and other details in advance
- In the afternoon you have a scheduled visit to the Bled Castle. You are at luck, because they currently organize Medieval days and Saturday will be packed with a whole bunch of workshops and performances. It starts at 9:00 and finished at 20:00, with a special knight performance by 3 groups at 16:00, so I would suggest you be there in time for the performances. As far as dinner is concerned, there are quite a few nice places in Bled, and you can get a wide variety of foods, anything from vegan, to Italian or Slovenian food, or burgers
